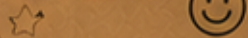

Not first. Not podium. But the original goal was met: the entry came back, the system held up, and the learning was worth more than the table.

The strategy was solid. The execution had one visible gap.

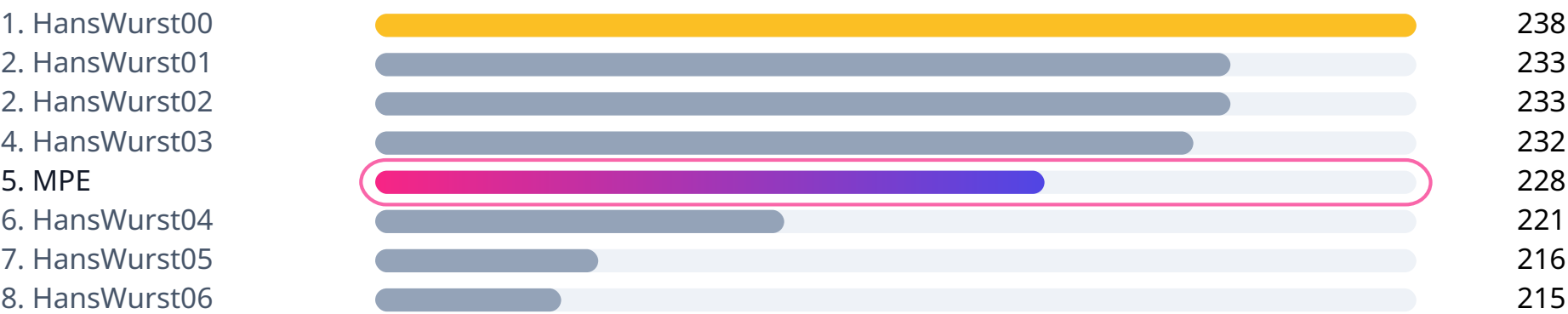
Two R16 entries were never submitted. That created guaranteed zeroes. The counterfactual is unknowable, but the process lesson is obvious: the highest-leverage fix is not a smarter model. It is never missing an entry.



What fifth place taught me.

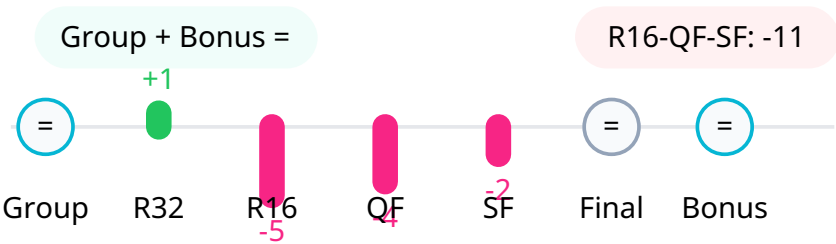
The strategy held. The late knockout rounds exposed execution risk.

Where the ten-point deficit actually came from.



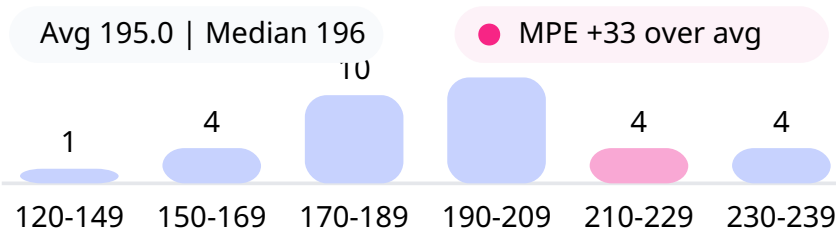
Stage split

Result vs the full field.



Executive read

Signal over ego.

- Group + bonus matched the champion: 179 vs 179.
- R32 was stronger: 35 vs 34.
- R16-QF-SF created the title gap.

The real gain was orchestration.

Football was the dataset. The useful part was learning how to coordinate agentic AI for a messy, non-coding workflow: data extraction, checks, scenarios, summaries, and retrospectives.

01

Orchestrate, don't outsource

The agent helped structure the work. The responsibility for the decision stayed human.

02

Build boring guardrails

Reminder systems, rule-aware scoring, and deadline checks beat last-minute heroics.

03

Keep it social

The prize goes back into team pizza. Fun first. Optimization second.

+18 EUR

28 EUR payout minus 10 EUR entry.
The profit gets reinvested into the team.

The moral question stays open.

Is agentic AI fair in a casual prediction pool? Only if the rules and group norms allow it. The clean standard: disclose the tooling, respect house rules, and keep the game recognizably human.
